



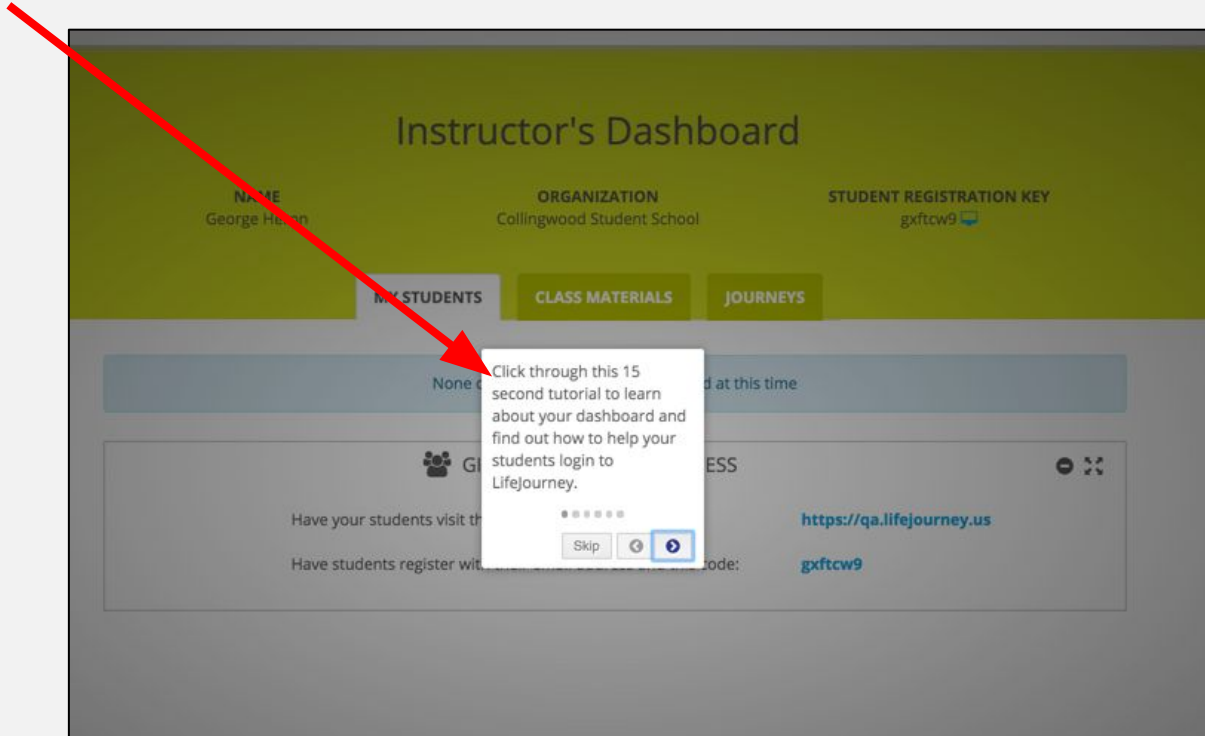

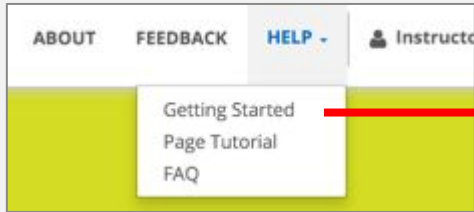

Getting Started in the Classroom

- There are 3 simple steps for successfully running the Day of STEM experience.


STEP 1 REGISTER
Complete registration when email notification received. Explore the capabilities in your new Instructor Dashboard.

STEP 2 RUN
Have students register using the Key on your dashboard, and see them appear in your dashboard. Conduct Part 1 of the Day of STEM. (45 minutes run time in classroom.) Students download STEM Resume when they reach their dashboard.

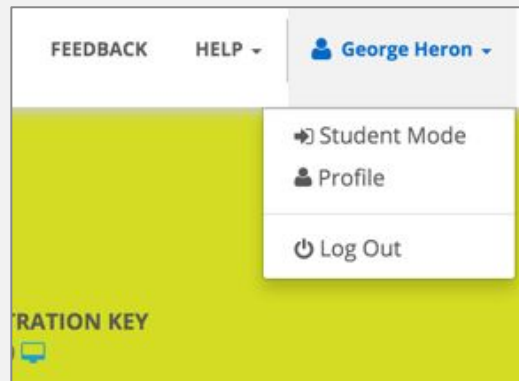
STEP 3 REPORT
Report on student selections and demographics. Have students start Part 2: STEM Cup Challenge from their dashboard. Continue Day of STEM throughout the school term. (Interactive class discussion, exercises, homework)

Feedback

Located in the Help menu, and available on every screen in the platform, you may select Feedback in order to provide suggestions to submit questions along the way.











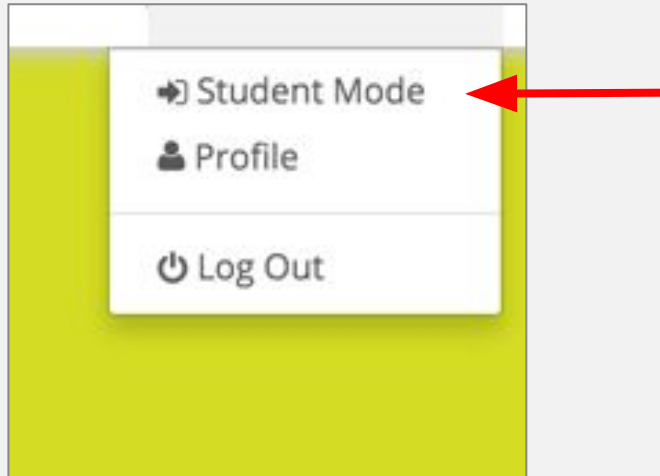
Capology Lesson Guide

Student Mode




Student Mode is an important tool available to instructors for running the Day of STEM platform just as students normally experience it.

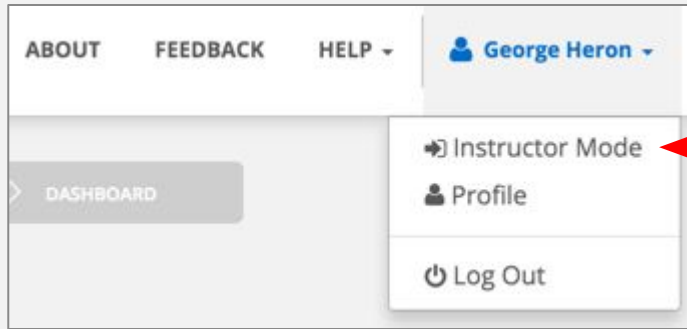

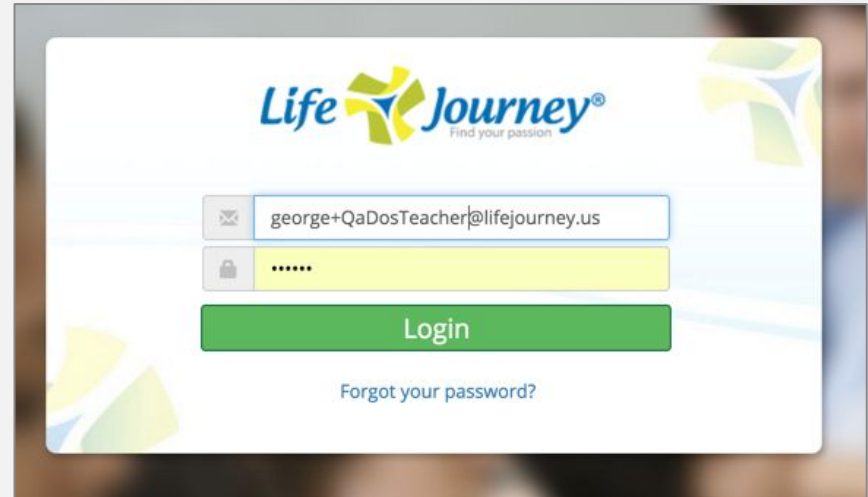
